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

Sachin Ramesh Tendulker was born on 24 April 1973. He is an Indian cricketer widely regarded as one of the greatest batsman in the history of cricket. In 2002, just 12 years into his career, Wisden ranked him the 2nd greatest Test batsman of all time, behind Donald Bradman, and the second greatest one-day-international (ODI) batsman of all time, behind Viv Richards.
